

## Workload Obligations for Obtaining Credit Points with “Language Learning in a Tandem“ (5 CP) (at least B1 in the CEFR) (August 2022)

The students will get 5 CP for fulfilling the workload.

<b>Participating in a Language Learning Coaching (setting of the learning and examination goals as well as examination format) and in a Final Coaching (evaluation of the project)</b>	2 sessions = 4 hours
<b>Training the necessary competences in the target language with the partner</b>	min. 13 sessions à 2 hours = 26 hours
<b>Preparation of the sessions and follow-up work</b>	13 hours
<b>Language Café</b>	1 session
<b>Participating in Learning Relevant Activities outside the Tandem Learning Partnership (ascertainment will take place in the Language Learning Coaching)</b>	min. 3 sessions = 15 hours
<b>Participating in Obligatory Consultation (incl. preparation and follow-up)</b>	4 hours
