### Requirements for participants of the course „English for Academic Purposes III (C1)“

- 1) You are enrolled in the course „English for Academic Purposes III (C1)“,
- 2) You have **actively** participated in the course and completed **all required assignments** (text submission, Moodle portfolios, etc.),
- 3) Your final course grade is **equal to or better than 2.0**.

If you fulfil all these conditions, you will be allowed to take the exams for UNicert<sup>®</sup> English III

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### Six simple steps to your UNICert<sup>®</sup> certificate:

1. **On-time online registration on the homepage of the ZfA**
2. **Payment of the 35€ fee** after reception of the invoice and your **course grade (≥2,0)**
3. **Arrangement of the date** for the oral examination with your lecturer
4. Participation in the **oral** and **written** examinations
5. **Evaluation** of the performance and production of the certificate by the ZFA
6. **Delivery** of the certificate

- **Certification is based on participation in the course, the end-of-course examinations and a separate UNICert<sup>®</sup> examination in all four areas of competence (see below)**
- **Exam dates are to be found on the homepage or through your lecturer**
- **(Examination-)formats: All four competences will be tested, i.e. oral and written production and reading and listening comprehension**
